Sponsored by Rolls-Royce Corporation, Helicopters Business Unit

This is a \$1000 scholarship to support the costs of attending a college or university. The selected student will also have the opportunity to work as a Rolls-Royce Helicopters Engineering intern during the summer of 2005.

Criteria:

1. Applicants must be a 2004 high school graduate.
2. Applicants must be from one of the three IRI host teams – Team 45, 234 or 393 and attending a college or university full time during the fall of 2004.
3. Applicants must be pursuing an education in Engineering or Engineering Technology. The university does not have to be in Indiana.
4. Applicants need to submit a 750 word maximum essay containing two key elements.
 - * Your FIRST experience. Describe your experiences, skills, and/or stories about FIRST and its influence on you.
 - * A view of how you would benefit from an Engineering Internship.

4. Applicants must also have two FIRST mentors to fill out the recommendation form (pages 2 and 3). These mentors need to send their recommendations to IRIScholar2@indianafirst.org by June 30th. One mentor must be from your team.
5. The applicant must be in good team standing and on FIRST team 234, 393 or 45 and be attending the 2004 IRI.

These applications will be reviewed and judged by an independent team of Rolls-Royce Engineering Managers. The scholarship / internship winner will be announced during the awards ceremony.
